


Prefixes

- The next two slides contain prefixes that are used for the medical terminology of most human systems.
- Prefixes are used at the beginning of a word to modify or vary the meaning of the word.
- ► When the prefixes are detached from a term, it is followed by a hyphen (-).

| a-, an- | no, not, without, away |
| aut- | self |
| end-, endo- | within, inside |
| exo- | outside of, without |
| epi- | above |
| hyper- | excessive |
| hypo- | insufficient |

- The next two slides contain suffixes that can be used for the medical terminology of most human systems.
- Suffixes are placed at the end of a word root or word part to modify or vary the meaning.
- Suffixes can indicate a condition, disease or procedure.
- When a suffix is written detached it is preceded by a hyphen (-).

| 8 | -centesis | surgical puncture as to aspirate or remove fluid |
| | -cision | process of cutting |
| | -ectomy | excision (surgical removal or cutting out) |
| | -gram | a drawing or a written record |
