
English Short Vowels:

- 2. /e/: bed /bed/ head /hed/, red /red/, friend /frend/ bread/bred/.
- 3. /æ/: man /mæn/, fan /fæn/ ran /ræn/ can /kæn/.

- 4. $/\Lambda$: but/b Λ t/ hut/h Λ t/ blood /bl Λ d/ flood /fl Λ d/ cut/k Λ t/, rough /r Λ f/.
- 5. /ɔ/: hot /hɔt/, lock /lɔk/, shock / \int ɔk/, cough /kɔf/.
